Check-in will begin on Friday, April 4th at 3:00 PM at the check-in counter on the main floor of the Memorial Union. Friday night will include a barbeque, Lip Sync performances, and block parties in Greek Land. What Should I Bring to Greek Getaway?

Upon arrival in Ames, please park your car in the East Campus Parking Deck (shown with sun) across from the Gerdin Business Building. Your car will remain there until checkout. From the Parking Deck, please bring all the items you will need for the weekend to the lobby of the Memorial Union, where check in will be taking place.
